Dear Current or Prospective Student,

The Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) requires that Institutions make available to their students information regarding certain outcomes of their nursing programs. Currently, our Associate Degree Nursing program is accredited by ACEN.

Each year the annual reports for each accreditation agency are due near the end of the calendar year. As a result, the rates disclosed for the current calendar year are from the previous year's submitted annual report.

To follow is the 2017 annual report data for the school.

This information is compiled based on the requirements and accreditation standards established by ACEN. These standards can be located at: <http://www.acenursing.org/accreditation-manual/>. The student specific data is maintained, tracked and updated in our student data base system.

The following are the rates regarding our student graduates' success on the licensure examination to become a Registered Nurse, students' completion of the nursing program, and the percentage of students who have obtained a job within a specified timeframe after graduation.

The methodology and time frame applicable to these rates is as follows:

### **Licensure Exam Rate Methodology**

The licensure exam rates are based on first year candidates who took the exam from January 1, 2016 thru December 31, 2016. These rates are based on the 2016 calendar year results as reported by the Florida Board of Nursing.

### **Completion Rate Methodology**

The completion rate of 43% is based on students that started their core nursing classes between 1/1/15 thru 12/31/15. The graduation rate is calculated by dividing total graduates by students available for graduation. The methodology is defined by ACEN.

### **Placement Rate Methodology**

The annual reporting period is July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017. The placement rate cohort is for students that have graduated between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017. This rate is based on data submitted to our Institutional accreditation agency: Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools (ABHES).

Placement rates are calculated by dividing employed graduates by total graduates. To be considered a placement the student must have graduated and must meet the following requirements:

- Graduates must be licensed as a Registered Nurse (RN) with a state board in the U.S.
- Graduates must be employed a minimum of 5 days
- Excludes those who have returned to formal education

Placements are determined by a graduate working in their field. Placement information is verified with the employer. For examples of types of employment obtained by our graduates, please review your catalog and/or consult with your Career Service's office.
