Dear Current or Prospective Student,

The Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) of 2008, under the Program Integrity Rules relating to Gainful Employment, requires that Institutions make available to their students information regarding state placement rates, including the methodology and time frame applicable to the rates.

To follow is the 2017 state annual report placement rate data for the school. This information is required to be disclosed for the 2018 calendar year. Please understand that each year the annual reports are due near the end of the calendar year. As a result, the rates disclosed for the current year are from the previous year's submitted annual report. Disclosures are updated within a reasonable timeframe after the submission date.

This information is compiled based on the requirements of our state agency. Information is maintained, tracked and updated in our student data base system.

The methodology and time frame applicable to these rates is as follows:

State Agency: Pennsylvania Department of Education

The reporting period is July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. Placement statistics are calculated per program.

Placements are determined by a graduate working in their field or a related field as described above. Placement information is verified with the employer.
