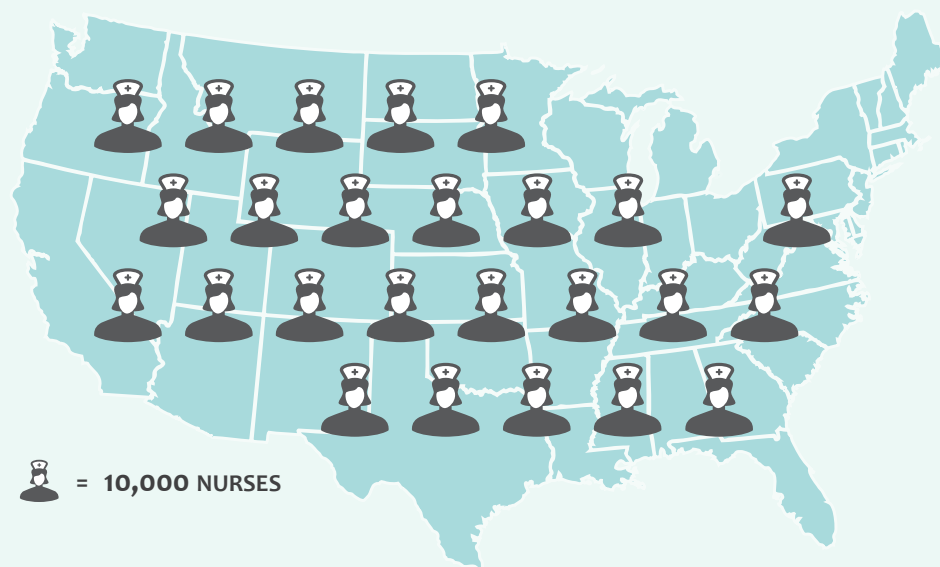


What can YOU do with a NURSING EDUCATION?

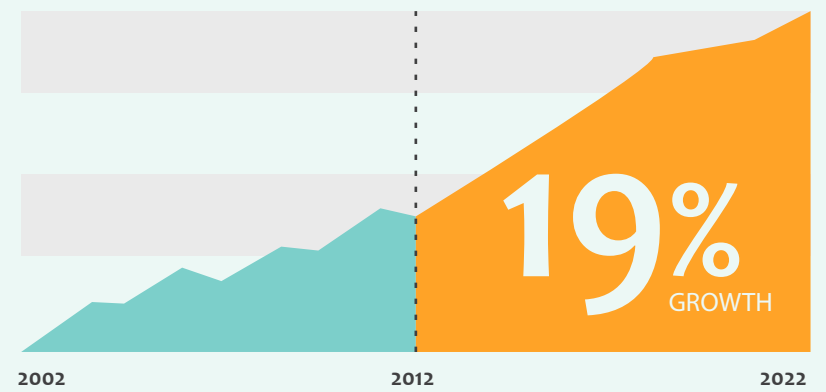


Nursing is among the **TOP 10** largest occupations in America, in both the public and private sectors.

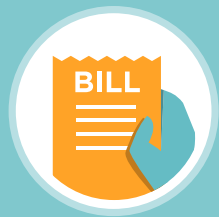
Aging Population:

Nurses needed to educate and care for patients with chronic conditions, such as arthritis, dementia, diabetes, Alzheimer's disease & obesity



Greater Same-Day Care Procedures:

More sophisticated procedures that were previously done only in hospitals are being performed in ambulatory care settings and physicians' offices



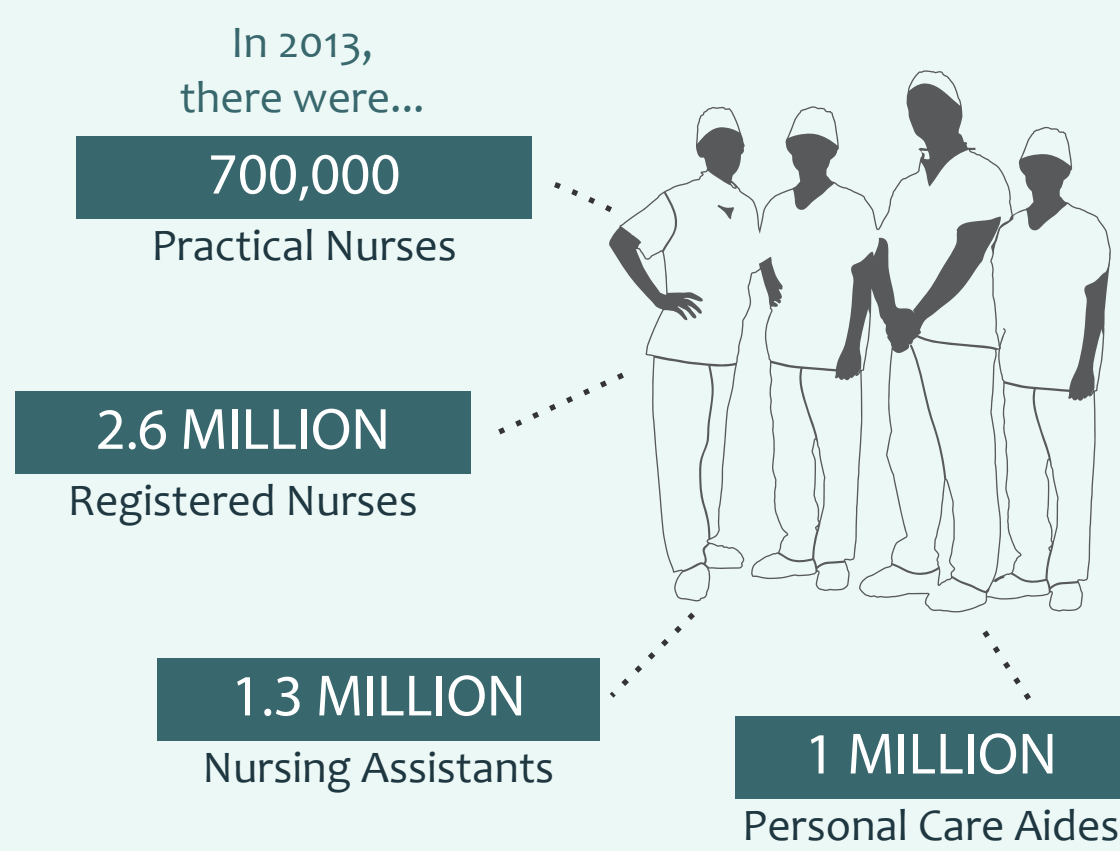
Financial Pressure:

Hospitals will try to discharge patients as soon as possible which may result in more admittance to long-term care facilities, outpatient care centers & home healthcare



Retirement Replacement:

Nurses retiring will need to be replaced at a higher rate to combat the growing number of people with access to healthcare services

Nurses are also needed in specialized fields like oncology, cardiac care, neurology, natal care and gynecology.

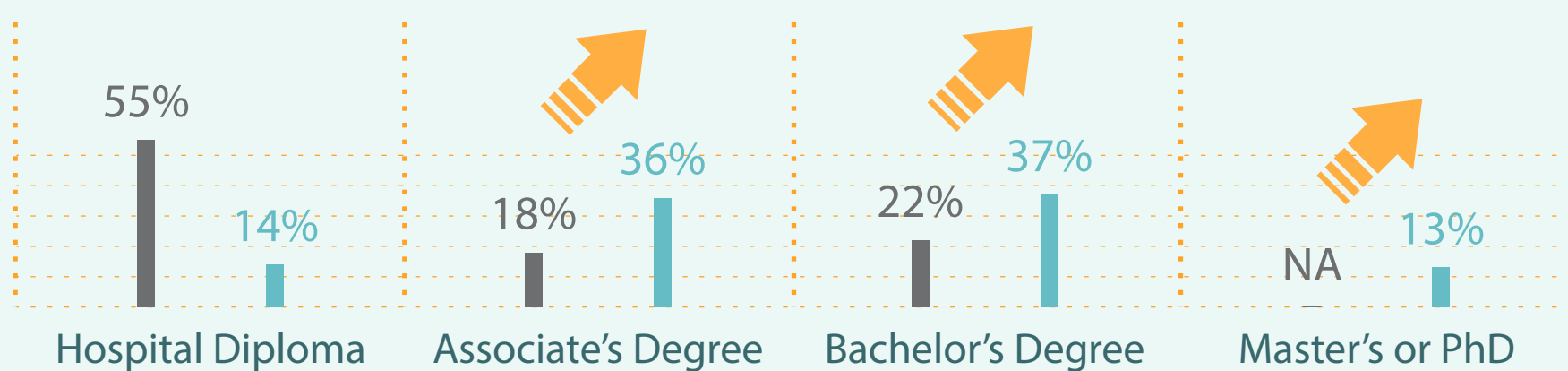
